

Driving FROM JOHANNESBURG

- From Johannesburg, take the M1 North to Pretoria via Centurion.
- Drive straight along this highway and follow the Pietersburg/N1 North signs. The M1 North eventually becomes the N1 North.
- When close to Pietersburg/Polokwane, follow the N1 North signs towards Louis Trichardt/Makhado. Follow the N1 North, past the turn-off to Louis Trichardt and proceed towards Musina.
- Proceed along the N1 and approximately 57 kms after the turn-off to Louis Trichardt (just after the Baobab Toll Gate), you'll find the R525 turn-off to Tshipise and Pafuri to your right.
- Take this turn-off to your right and proceed along the R525, straight on past the turn-off to Tshipise. Please be careful of potential potholes or stray animals like cattle, wild donkeys and goats on this road.
- Enter the Kruger National Park through Pafuri Gate. Please tell the gate guard that you are staying at The Outpost and he will reduce your entry fee into the Kruger Park. From this gate travel until you see the sign for The Outpost (approx 5.6 kms). The sign is built from rocks and is on the left-hand side of the road.
- Turn right at the sign and follow the dirt road for 4 kms until you reach The Outpost.

Flying WITH ECHO SKIES

You can fly to The Outpost with Echo Skies from Grand Central (JHB), O.R. Tambo (JHB) or Hoedspruit Civil. Flights are available daily, Monday to Sunday, and will land in the Pafuri airstrip, which is in the same concession as The Outpost and Pel's Post. Guests will be collected by their guide and taken for a game drive back to the lodge.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- The service station at Tshipise is the last service station along the route, so please check your fuel as it is still approximately 120 kms to The Outpost from this point.
- There is no fuel pump at Pafuri Gate, so please ensure you have enough fuel for your journey back to Tshipise, or south through the Kruger National Park after your stay at The Outpost.
- The last reliable cellphone reception is at Tshipise, so if you need to make a call, this is the point to do so.
- There are six toll plazas between Johannesburg and Pafuri Gate:
 - Pumulani Plaza
 - Kranskop Lane
 - Capricorn Lane
 - Carousel Plaza
 - Nyl Lane
 - Baobab Lane

Air & road TRANSFERS

There are no scheduled road transfers to the lodge, however they can be arranged upon request through our preferred suppliers from Johannesburg and surrounding areas. Should you wish to fly in via private aircraft and land on the airstrip, please get in touch and we will assist with the necessary arrangements.
