The guiding service should be delivered with uncompromising sensitivity towards the environment and utmost respect for the Makuleke Contractual Park and the wider Kruger National Park.

As a Guide, you are the link between the lodge, our team and our guests, ensuring effective communication between all parties, especially in relation to guiding requirements. Game drive vehicles and related equipment are also the responsibility of the Field Guide and should be driven and maintained with care, consideration and according to company standards.

Guides are also responsible for their own continuous education and are expected to undertake continual self-assessment, self-improvement and knowledge enhancement.

This position is accountable to the Head Guide.
